

# HOW TO APPLY FOR AN ETA AT THE AIRPORT

## Required items:

- ❑ A smartphone or device with **internet connection**
- ❑ A **valid passport** for UK travel
- ❑ Access to email
- ❑ Payment method



**Note:** British or Irish dual nationals **cannot** apply an ETA. Proof of citizenship will be required.

## Download the app to start your ETA application

No personal data is stored on the app, and you can delete it once you have submitted your application.

If you do not have a compatible smartphone, you can apply online at [gov.uk/eta/apply](https://www.gov.uk/eta/apply)



Move out of the check-in queue to a quiet space



### 1. Start application

Apply in a well-lit space with a good internet connection

Do not worry if the characters in your name look slightly different (i.e., missing accents).



### 2. Scan your passport photo page

Open your passport to the biographic page and hold your phone over your passport

Lay the passport on a flat, **non-metal surface**



### 3. Scan passport chip

Use the photos in the app to guide you on where to position your phone on your passport.

Remove any **phone and passport covers** on your device.

Skip this step if you do not have a chipped passport or it is not working



### 4. Take a photo of yourself

Take a neutral photo in a well-lit area with even lighting. Use a plain background.

Check that all information has scanned correctly from passport. Edit any errors.

### 5. Finish and Pay

Review information and submit. Make payment using preferred method.

Emails cannot be accepted as proof of ETA.



### 6. Wait for confirmation

Wait for email confirmation before returning to the check-in agent.

Return to the check-in agent to complete your check-in

**No face coverings** (unless for religious or medical reasons)
